AREA OVERVIEW



Hamtramck, MI

Hamtramck is a city in Wayne County Michigan. Hamtramck is surrounded by the city of Detroit except for a small portion of the western border that touches the similarly surrounded city of Highland Park. Hamtramck lies about five miles (8 km) from the center of Detroit. The I-75 Freeway roughly runs along this city's western border and I-94 runs near its southern border. Detroit is the largest city in the state of Michigan and Hamtramck and Highland Park are surrounded by this metropolis but remain their own cities.

Hamtramck has a strong a diverse economy, however, at one time the automotive industry played a critical role in the city. Chrysler introduced the Dodge (1955) model of its car series here in November 1954. General Motors' Detroit/Hamtramck Assembly plant, one of the automaker's premiere facilities, produces the Cadillac DTS and the Buick Lucerne fuels the Hamtramck economy.

As of the census of 2010, there were 22,423 people 6,777 households and 4,615 families residing in the city. There were 8,693 housing units. The racial makeup of the city was 53.6% white (which includes people of Middle Eastern ancestry), 19.3% African American, 0.3% Native American, 21.5% Asian, and 4.7% from two or more races. Hispanic or Latino of any


race were 1.5% of the population.

There were 7,063 households out of which 38.4% had children under the age of 18 living with them, 40.3% were married couples living together, 18.1% had a female householder with no husband present, 7.0 had a male household with no wife and 34.7% were non-families. 29.9% households had someone living alone and of that, 9.2 were individuals who were 65 years of age or older. The average household size was 3.09 and the average family size was 3.98.




