

Family Dollar was founded in 1959 by Leon Levine, a 21-year-old entrepreneur. In November of that year, the company's first store was opened, in Charlotte, North Carolina. In 1961, their first store in South Carolina opened, followed by stores in Georgia and Virginia which were opened in 1962 and 1965, respectively.

During the 1960s, the company was largely a southern United States operation. By 1969, there were fifty stores in Charlotte alone. In addition to offering quality merchandise at low prices, Family Dollar is committed to the communities they service by supporting the nonprofit organizations that seek to improve the quality of life for customers and team members. Through a grass roots approach to giving, the Family Hope Community Foundation aids to give back to organizations that help local families in need.

On July 28, 2014, Dollar Tree announced that it would acquire Family Dollar for \$74.50 per share, a deal valuing Family Dollar at 8 5 billion, and that Dollar Tree would also assume 1 billion in debt currently owed by Family Dollar, for a total of 9 5 billion. Dollar Tree eyes at least 3K locations for rural concept stores

The format targets rural communities of 3,000 to 4,000 people. CFO Kevin Wampler told analysts the combination format could reach 3,000 stores "at a minimum," according to a Seeking Alpha transcript.

The retailer opened **32 combination stores in the second half of 2020,** and now operates a **total of 50**. Comparable **sales are up 20%** on average at the new format stores, Dollar Tree said.

Since Dollar Tree's acquisition of Family Dollar in 2015, the latter has been something of a problem child for the deep discounter. Family Dollar's sales often have lagged Dollar Tree's, and the company has closed hundreds of Family Dollar stores.

Dollar Tree plans a major expansion for a new concept store, introduced a little over a year ago, that combines its namesake and Family Dollar banners into a single storefront.

That trajectory, however, reversed during the pandemic, when Family Dollar's offering of food and **household essentials helped feed sales** as consumers stocked up their houses and consolidated trips.

The new format is meant to combine "Family Dollar's great value and assortment with Dollar Tree's 'thrill of the hunt' and fixed price-point — creating a new strategic store format targeted for small towns and rural communities," the company said. Those markets, it added, are areas where the retailer "would traditionally not open a Dollar Tree store alone."



Nettie, WV is an unincorporated census-designated place in Nicholas County, West Virginia, United States.

Nicholas County was created by the Virginia legislature from parts of Greenbrier, Kanawha, and Randolph counties on January 30, 1818.

Nicholas County is part of the 4C Economic Development Authority, which was created to foster regional economic growth

Located in central West Virginia on the Allegheny Plateau, Nicholas County encompasses 654.1 square miles, with economic resources including bituminous coal, limestone quarries, timber, fruit farms, tobacco, and livestock.

Its two largest cities are Summersville, the county seat, and Richwood.

Around the turn of the 20th century, the railroad brought economic growth to Nicholas County. The lumber industry expanded rapidly, and the Cherry River Boom and Lumber Company built one of the world's largest sawmills at Richwood. Other industries followed, including a paper mill, handle and hub factories, a tannery, and what was then the world's largest clothespin factory. Later in the 20th century, coal led another economic surge, until the coal industry softened in the 1970s and early 1980s.

Nicholas County has many other points of interest. The Carnifex Ferry Battlefield State Park is an important historic site. The county is known for its annual county fair, the big ramp festival at Richwood, and the potato festival at Summersville. Music in the Mountains, one of America's major bluegrass festivals, is held at Summersville each summer.

Congresswoman Miller announces investment in Nicholas County

The investment will be used to implement a Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy (CEDS) for the Region IV Planning and Development Council that serves Fayette, Nicholas, Greenbrier, Pocahontas, and Webster Counties.

"Thank you to the Economic Development Administration for this crucial investment in rural America," said Congresswoman Miller. "This funding will support our existing businesses, create new jobs, and strengthen the region. As we work to revitalize West Virginia's economy, this funding is a welcomed step closer to reaching our goal."

Congresswoman Miller (R-WV) today announced an Economic Development Administration Investment worth \$70,000 in Nicholas County.

The CEDS will bring together **public and private partnerships** to make an economic development plan. The investment covers half of the project cost bringing the project total to \$140,000.



\$750k Grant Funding to New River Gorge Regional Development **Authority**

In Raleigh County, New River Gorge Regional Development Authority was awarded \$750,000 dollars to be used for recapitalization of the organization's revolving loan fund which will be used to lend directly to businesses located within their four-county footprint (Fayette, Nicholas, Raleigh, and Summers counties) that have been negatively impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic.

These funds are part of a larger state-wide collaborative effort including New River Gorge Regional Development Authority, Wyoming County EDA, The Center for Rural Health, Natural Capital Investment Fund, Mid-Ohio Valley Regional Council, and Woodlands Development Group, to bring new loan monies to small businesses across West Virginia.


Governor Jim Justice announced West Virginia Appalachian Regional Commission (ARC) Investment Program Grant funding has been awarded to 12 projects across the state totaling \$11.7 Million dollars.

"The \$750,000 recapitalization of the NRGRDA Revolving Loan Fund will be specifically targeted at small businesses needing working capital at a very challenging time," said Joe Brouse, Executive Director, "We know Governor Justice, the West Virginia Development Office, and the Appalachian Regional Commission desire to see West Virginia companies come back stronger than ever. This award demonstrates that commitment to a strong recovery for the New River Gorge region.
