OLATHE, KS

Olathe is part of Johnson County and the Kansas City major metropolitan area. It is located in northeastern Kansas, which is only twenty miles away from Kansas City. It is the fourth most populous city in the state and the fourth-largest city in the Kansas City metropolitan area. It is bordered by the cities of Lenexa to the north, Overland Park to the east, and Gardner to the southwest.

Olathe's commercial and industrial parks are home to many companies, including Honeywell, Husqvarna, ALDI, Garmin, Grundfos, and Farmers Insurance Group. Although Farmers Insurance is based in Los Angeles California, Olathe has more Farmers employees than any other city in the United States.

Olathe is a developing community with a new apartment complex, a new courthouse, and a new public library currently under construction in Downtown Olathe. These projects are sure to bring in new opportunities and new jobs in the area.

Popular spots locals and tourists can explore in Olathe include the Mahaffie Stagecoach Stop & Farm Historic Site, the Ernie Miller Park & Nature Center, and the Kansas City Automotive Museum. Olathe is also home to MidAmerica Nazarene University, a small private university. In addition, a Johnson County Community College campus and a Kansas State University campus are also located in Olathe.

DOWNTOWN DEVELOPMENTS

- Arrello Apartments Project (2mi from property): Milhaus is building a \$37 million apartment complex located at 110 & 120 S. Chestnut Street in Downtown Olathe. Arrello, the name of the apartment complex, will have 228 apartment units ranging from studios to 3 bedrooms. Arrello is set to open in the winter of 2021-2022.
- Downtown Olathe Public Library (2mi from property): LANE4 Property Group is working on a mixed-use building in Downtown Olathe. The 5-story, 70,000 square foot building will be the home of a restaurant, a public library, and offices. The community space will be east of the Olathe City Hall on Santa Fe Street.
- Johnson County Courthouse Construction (2mi from property): The \$193 million courthouse will include 28 courtrooms with room for expansion as the city population continues to grow. The building is over 350,000 square feet wide and 7 stories tall. The courthouse is across Santa Fe Street north of the existing courthouse and west of Olathe City Hall. It is anticipated to be open for business by January 4, 2021.

POINTS OF INTEREST

MAHAFFIE STAGECOACH STOP & FARM HISTORIC SITE

The historic site sits on 40 acres of farmland where visitors can learn about a farm that has been around since the 1860s. It is the last existing stagecoach stop on the Santa Fe Trail. The farm has been converted to a museum and gift shop but remains to be the home of oxen, horses, and other livestock. Visitors can participate in activities that were part of the daily life of the Mahaffie family and their neighbors.under one roof.




The park and nature center sits on a 116-acre property where visitors can walk trails, relax at the picnic shelter, or visit the education center to learn about animals and participate in activities. The park also has an outdoor amphitheater that seats 80 people. It is a popular spot for weddings, graduations, birthdays, and corporate events.

KANSAS CITY AUTOMOTIVE MUSEUM

The 10,000 square foot museum is home to 30 vehicles that were significant to Kansas City's automotive history. The museum rotates the 30 vehicles every 4-6 months. Visitors can learn about the 1965 Le Mans winner Masten Gregory (the "Kansas City Flash"), the Ford Winchester Plant, and Greenlease Cadillac at the museum. Visitors can also participate in professional driving simulators. The museum also hosts car club meetings and other special events throughout the year.







KANSAS CITY, KS

Marquee events are also in abundance in the Sunflower State. Electrifying Sporting Kansas City soccer and high-powered Kansas Speedway races are quintessential KC sports experiences. Then there's the American Royal World Series of Barbecue, an iconic fall tradition dating back decades. Urban explorers thrive in KCK's authentic and diverse neighborhoods. Between sips of craft beer brewed right in Strawberry Hill and bites of mouthwatering barbecue or scratch-made tortillas—plus great skyline views and moving murals—there's never a dull moment here.







UNIVERSITY OF MISSOURI - KANSAS CITY

UMKC got its start in 1930 with a gift from William Volker, a man fondly remembered for his generosity. His purchase of 40 acres just south of The Nelson-Atkins Museum of Art became the UMKC Volker campus. Six years later, 80 students became the first graduating class at UMKC. Now, the university hosts more than a dozen commencement ceremonies each year to accommodate all of our graduates. Its history is one of partnerships and progress, expansion and education.

Located just 4 miles from the subject property, UMKS is the largest comprehensive, fully accredited university in the Kansas City area. The faculty are leaders in their fields — and they're within reach. The 14:1 student-to-faculty ratio means professors know their students' names and take mentorship seriously. Students come from all 50 states and 85+ countries, enriching the community with diverse perspectives. And with more than 125 academic areas, students have a lot of opportunities to explore on their way to discovering and creating their perfect career. The university is at the heart of a thriving urban area, and the city's life and energy influence everything that happens there.







KC CHIEFS

The Kansas City Chiefs are a professional American football team based in Kansas City, Missouri. The Chiefs compete in the National Football League (NFL) as a member club of the league's American Football Conference (AFC) West division. The team was founded in 1960 as the Dallas Texans by businessman Lamar Hunt and was a charter member of the American Football League (AFL). In 1963, the team relocated to Kansas City and assumed its current name. The Chiefs joined the NFL in 1970 and is valued at over \$2 billion.

The Chiefs have won three AFL championships, in 1962, 1966, and 1969.[9] They became the second AFL team (after the New York Jets) to defeat an NFL team in an AFL-NFL World Championship Game, when they defeated the Minnesota Vikings in Super Bowl IV. Recently, the Chiefs have won 4 of their last 5 playoff games, including Super Bowl LIV in 2020, which earned the franchise their first championship in 50 years.



KC ROYALS

Kansas City Royals, American professional baseball team based in Kansas City, Missouri. The Royals have won four American League (AL) pennants and two World Series championships (1985 and 2015). The Royals were founded in 1969 as an expansion franchise that was granted by Major League Baseball after the Kansas City Athletics moved to Oakland the previous year. The Royals did not take long to overcome the usual trials of an expansion club; they finished in second place in the AL Western Division three times in their first seven seasons.

In 2013 a young Royals roster finally broke through after years of frustration and posted the franchise's best record (86-76) since the strike-shortened 1994 season, finishing five games out of a berth in the postseason.

Kansas City built on that momentum the following year and captured an AL wild-card position. The team then won a dramatic extra-inning wild-card contest and swept its Division Series to earn a spot in the AL Championship Series. There the Royals swept the Baltimore Orioles to advance to the World Series, becoming the first team in major league history to open a postseason with eight consecutive victories.
