McDonald's Corporation is the world's largest chain of hamburger fast food restaurants, serving over 69 million customers daily throughout 100 countries.

McDonald's primarily sells hamburgers, cheeseburgers, chicken, French-fries, breakfast items, soft drinks, shakes and desserts. In response to changing consumer tastes, the **company has expanded its menu** to include salads, wraps, smoothies and fruit. McDonald's restaurants offer customers counter service as well as drive-thru service. McDonald's owns **approximately 18%** of their restaurants, while the remainder of the stores are run by **franchisee members** or joint venture.

McDonald's Corporation operates and franchises McDonald's restaurants in the United States and internationally. Its restaurants offer various food products, soft drinks, coffee, and other beverages, as well as breakfast menu. As of December 31, 2019, the **company operated 38,695**. McDonald's present corporation dates its founding to the opening of a franchised restaurant by businessman Ray Kroc in Des Plaines, Illinois on April 15, 1955, the **ninth McDonald's restaurant overall**. Kroc purchased the McDonald brothers' equity in the company and led its **worldwide expansion**. McDonald's is a publically traded company on the New York Stock Exchange using symbol "MCD". McDonald's is an investment grade rated company with a Standard & Poor's rating of **"BBB+"**. McDonald's moved their global headquarters to Chicago, Illinois in 2017 from Oak Brook, Illinois where they have had their offices since **1971**.

McDonald's is testing automated drive-thru ordering at 10 Chicago restaurants

Kempczinski said the restaurants using the voice-ordering technology are seeing about 85% order accuracy. Only about a fifth of orders need to be a taken by a human at those locations, he said, speaking at Alliance Bernstein's Strategic Decisions conference.

Over the last decade, restaurants have been leaning more into technology to improve the **customer experience** and help save on labor. In 2019, under former CEO Steve Easterbrook, McDonald's went on a spending spree, snapping up restaurant tech. One of those acquisitions was Apprento, which **uses artificial intelligence software** to take drive-thru orders. Financial terms of the deal were not disclosed.

At 10 McDonald's locations in Chicago, workers aren't taking down customers' drive-thru orders for McNuggets and french fries — a computer is, CEO Chris Kempczinski said Wednesday.

Kempczinski said the technology will likely take more than **one or two years** to implement. "Now there's a big leap from going to **10 restaurants** in Chicago to **14,000 restaurants** across the U.S., with an infinite number of promo permutations, menu permutations, dialect permutations, weather — and on and on and on," he said.

Another challenge has been training restaurant workers to stop themselves from jumping in to help.

McDonald's says sales are back to prepandemic levels

Revenues for the quarter rose to \$5.12 billion, topping the \$4.7 billion brought in a year ago as well as the \$4.9 billion in the first quarter of 2019, before the pandemic struck.

Chris Kempczinski, the president and chief executive officer of McDonald's, touted the **company's rebound**, noting that it had occurred "**even as resurgences and operating restrictions persist in many parts of the world.**"

Global same-store sales grew 7.5 percent in the first quarter from the year-earlier period. That was driven by a big jump of 13.6 percent in the United States, McDonald's reported.

Profit in the quarter climbed to **\$1.5 billion, from \$1.1 billion a year** earlier.

Chicken was one of the big drivers for growth in the U.S. The company brought back its spicy chicken nuggets for a limited time and **entered the competitive** chicken-sandwich market with its own version in February.

"While the category is **very competitive**, we are so far exceeding our projections," Joe Erlinger, the president of McDonald's U.S.A., told Wall Street analysts on a call. "We are selling substantially more chicken sandwiches than our previous chicken-sandwich line," particularly in the late afternoon, he said.

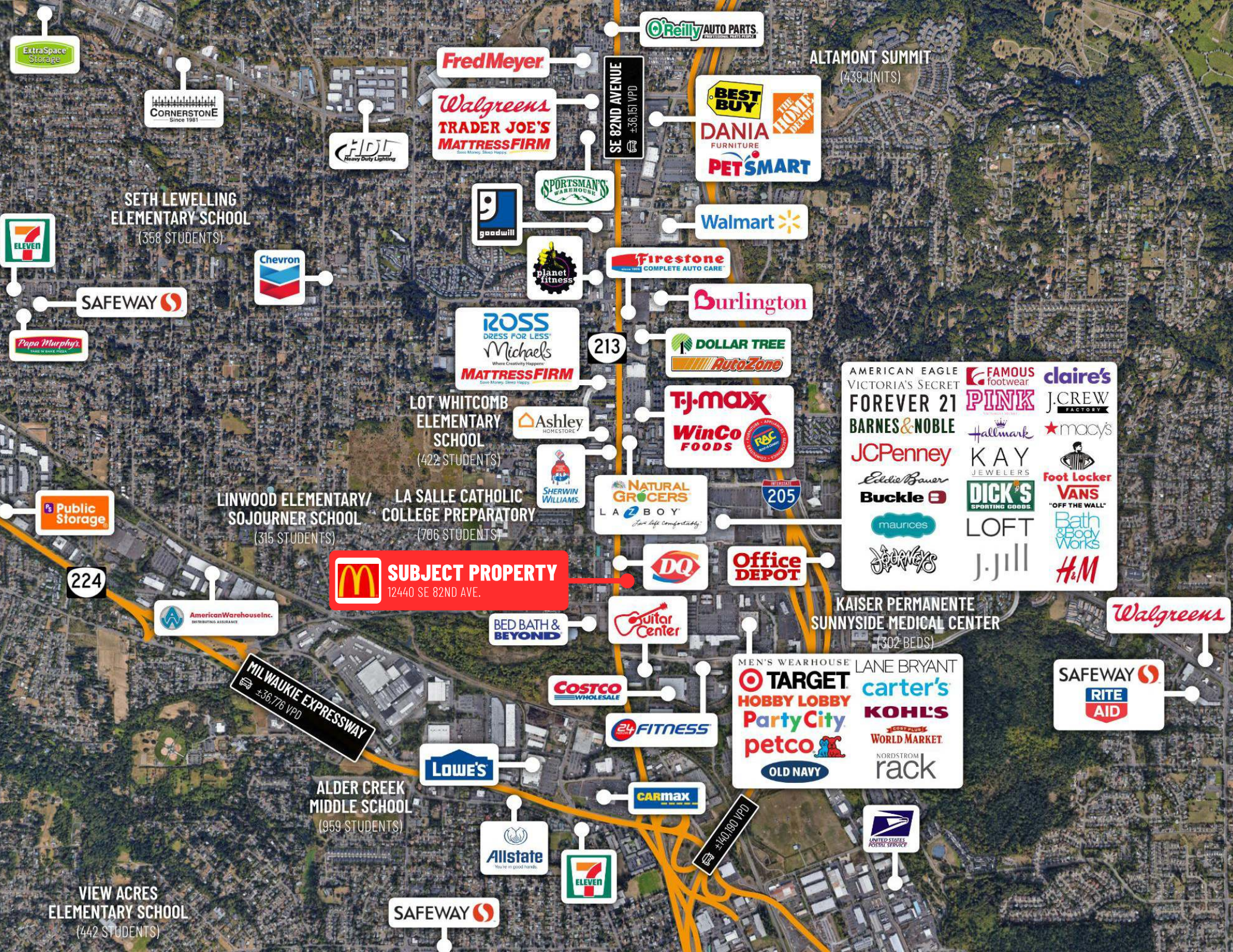

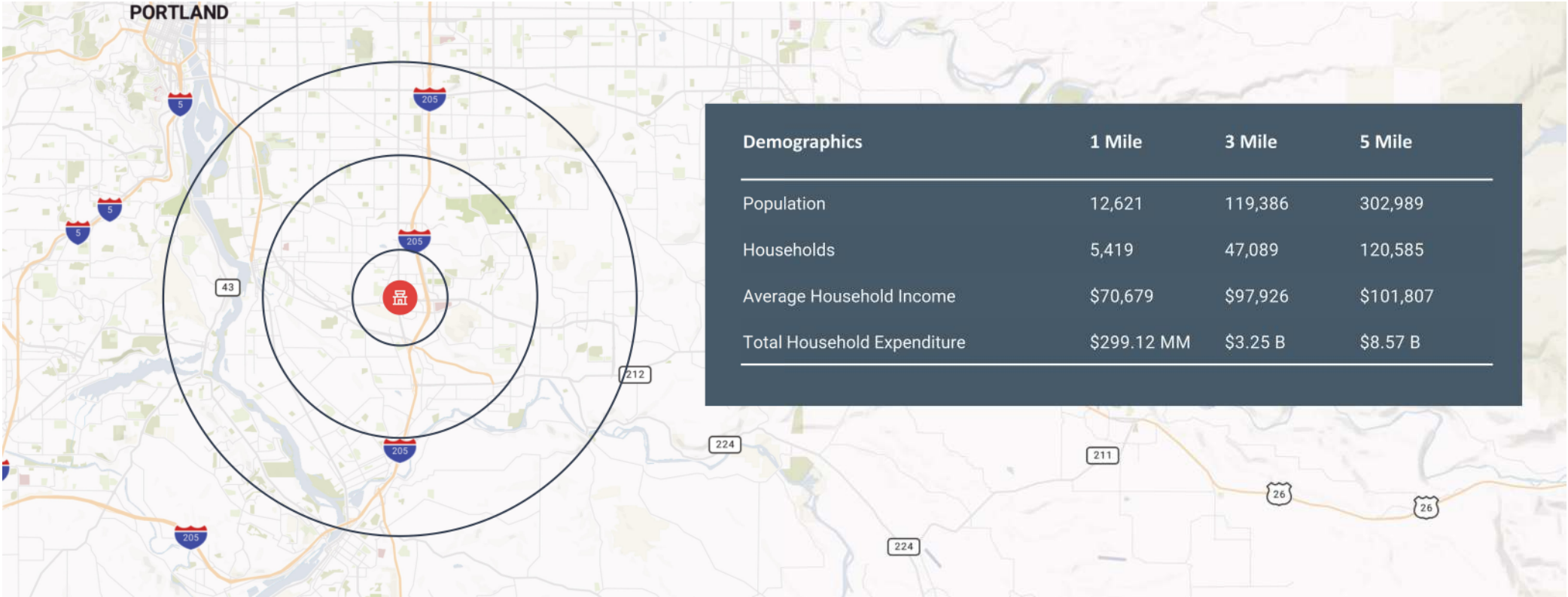

Oregon City-Area Unemployment Rate Decreased In July: Feds

The U.S. economic recovery slowed in August, particularly in the job market, as the coronavirus' delta variant spread across the country.

Nationally, non-farm payroll employment rose by **235,000 jobs** in August, which was tepid compared with the **1.1 million jobs** added in July and **962,000** in June, according to the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics.

The Clackamas County unemployment rate was 4.4 percent in July, down from 4.9 percent in June. That reflected significant improvement from June 2020, when the unemployment rate stood at 9.6 percent.

The national unemployment rate dropped **0.2 percentage points to 5.2 percent** in August. The latest available local unemployment figures are for July; the rate improved since June in the Oregon City area, and continues to be much lower than the beginning of the pandemic. The July unemployment rate in Clackamas County was lower than the Oregon rate of **4.8 percent**, according to the latest local figures from the BLS.

Nationally, 17 million jobs were added back to the economy since April 2020. Still, the country is down **5.3 million positions (3.5 percent)** from pre-pandemic levels. Average hourly wages grew for the fifth month in a row with a 17-cent gain in August, up to **\$30.73**.

The leisure and hospitality industry job gains stalled in August after averaging **350,000 new jobs** per month in the prior six months.

5 Things You Didn’t Know About Happy Valley, Oregon

When Shakespeare pondered, “What’s in a name?” ... he probably wasn’t thinking about neighborhood incorporation and real estate. But the origin of Happy Valley’s name brings a little intrigue to the table.

PSU’s Population Research Center data puts their growth rate from 2019 to 2020 at over 3%, which is well above the average rate for the metro area.

If your impression of Happy Valley is simply a faceless suburb on the **east side of the 205**, the story of the **“happy boys”** might surprise you. But it’s precisely this quirky combination of local charm and business savvy that makes Happy Valley the city it is today. Keep reading to discover five more intriguing aspects of Happy Valley.

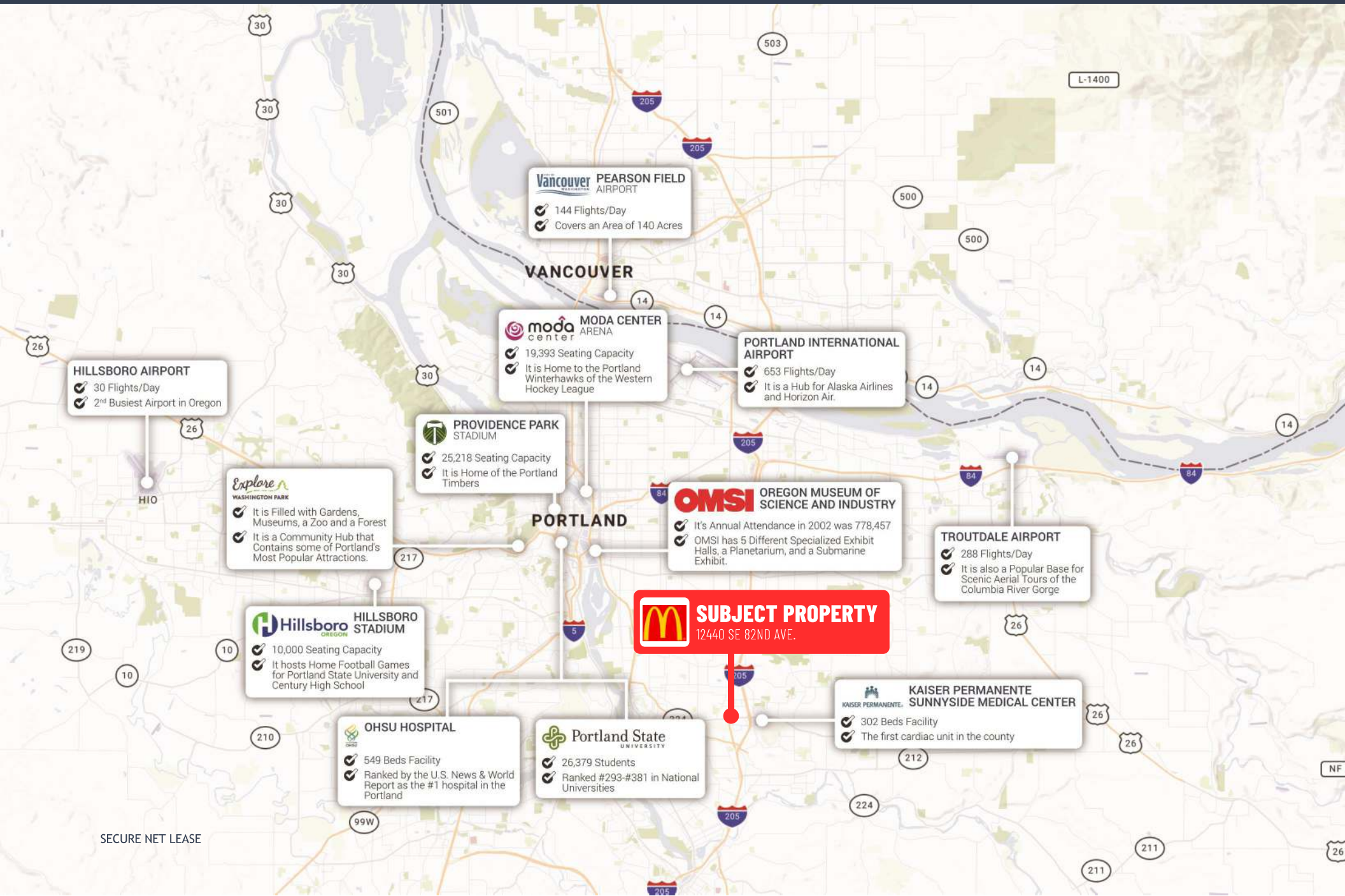
When Happy Valley incorporated in 1965, it was specifically to prevent annexation by Portland. Since then, the importance of maintaining a unique identity has informed the politics and policies of local governance.

Accordingly, the once **modest town’s growth** in recent years is not an out of control product of the real estate market. The forces that be have big plans. When Damascus disincorporated in **2011 (or tried to)**, Happy Valley jumped at the chance to annex anyone who was willing. And since 2018, plans have been in the works to annex parts of the Pleasant Valley and North Carver neighborhoods. This would add **over 1,700 households to the city**.
