


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SITE PLAN



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AREA MAP







Greater Louisville region is made up of 15 counties and home to more than 1.5 million people and over 58,000 businesses. Louisville is the **largest** city in Kentucky, Louisville is a competitive, inclusive, global city and home to both the Kentucky Derby and Muhammad Ali.

One of Louisville's oldest industries, bourbon, it is a cultural icon, a piece of heritage, a major employer, a draw for tourism, and popular Kentucky product. Louisville has experienced nearly \$150 million in investment in bourbon distilleries and experiences over the past several years. 30% of all distilling jobs in the U.S. are located in Kentucky.

The Kentucky Derby is held in Louisville at Churchill Downs, the legendary and historic horse-racing track. The Kentucky Derby, presented by Woodford Reserve, is a top-rank stakes race for 3-yearold Thoroughbreds. Over 155,000 people come to spectate and bet at one of the most popular horse races on the globe each year with an economic impact on the region estimated at \$34.6 million.

The region's health industry generates over \$80 billion in revenue. In logistics, UPS alone accounts for 20% of the workforce of 659,000, and its presence has attracted 200 companies to the area. Fortune 500 companies such as Kindred Healthcare, Yum!, and Humana are headquartered in Louisville, as are global headquarters for Brown-Forman Corp., UPS Airlines, Churchill Downs, Papa John's, Atria Senior Living, ResCare, GE Appliances, and many more. 


