



QuikTrip Celebrates 900th Store Milestone

QuikTrip Corp. (QT) is celebrating a company milestone with the opening of its 900th convenience store, located in Corsicana, Texas.

Over the course of the company's **63** years, it has grown to **12** states. Four more states — Tennessee, Arkansas, Alabama and Colorado — are scheduled to enter the pipeline in the next year, reported Tulsa World. "We are proud of the strategic progress QT has made over the course of our **63-year** history," QuikTrip Marketing Director Steve Wilson said in a statement. "To think back on this small grocery store that was started decades ago and look at where we are now, opening our **900th sophisticated convenience store**, is truly humbling.

QT's 900th store milestone comes just two years after the convenience operator celebrated its 800th store in the San Antonio, Texas metro area in 2019, followed by its 850th store in September 2020.

"Our team has worked incredibly hard to be at the forefront of the c-store industry," he added. "We hold a great amount of pride in our investment in our people and the communities we serve."

In 1958, Burt Holmes and Chester Cadieux invested their life savings to open the first QuikTrip, a small grocery store in their hometown of Tulsa.

Today, Tulsa-based QT has grown to a more than \$11 billion company and is consistently listed among Forbes' largest privately held companies.



How QuikTrip Is Investing in Its Leaders

Founded in 1958, QuikTrip Corp. (QT) has been a key player in transforming the convenience retailing landscape. Today, the 850-store chain has grown to a more than \$11 billion company with operations across 11 states, and is consistently listed among Forbes' largest privately held companies.

But at the core of QT's longevity and success is its **more than 24,000 employees**, who have contributed to the operator being named one of the Best Companies to **Work For for 14 years**.

With its leaders dispersed over multiple locations and with diverse responsibilities, QT was driven to create a common leadership language that could be used universally throughout the company and directly correlated to its mission to help employees grow and succeed.

"QuikTrip has a very powerful culture and is growing, which is why it needed a common leadership language. One of the most common constraints to a company that is looking to grow is that you have to have leaders who will perpetuate that culture," Marcia Dolby, principal learning partner, global solutions at HBP, told Convenience Store News. "Having a common leadership language helps to develop a talent pipeline that will help the company grow."

Joining forces to craft and define what "leadership" is and what it means to the company, QT and HBP created the **Advanced Leadership Program (ALP)** in 2015, aimed at high-potential leaders. They then added the **Master Leadership Program (MLP)**, which expands on the ALP.

The programs cover a gamut of lessons, such as decision making, effective communication, strategy, **delivering impact** and value, and managing and developing people. Courses consist of case studies, application and simulations, and lessons taught by Harvard faculty and authors.






Marietta is located in central Cobb County, Georgia, and is the county's seat and largest city.

The 2020 estimate is 60,867 residents, making it one of Atlanta's largest suburbs.

Located just northwest of Atlanta, Marietta, Georgia is perhaps best known as a destination for a charming turn-of-the-centurty square, quaint shops, beautiful parks, celebrated theatres, and unforgettable museums.

Marietta is the fourth largest of the principal cities (by population) of the Atlanta metropolitan area. The city is located 20 miles to Atlanta's downtown. Dobbins Air Reserve Base, located on the south side of Marietta, and the Lockheed Martin manufacturing plant are among the major industries in the city.

The Lockheed Georgia Employees Credit Union is based in Marietta, GA. Due to the city's close proximity, Atlanta's economy affects Marietta's. Atlanta's economy is considered diverse, with dominant sectors that include aerospace, transportation, logistics, professional and business services, media operations, medical services, and information technology. Atlanta's economy is the 8th largest in the county and the 17th-largest in the world. Corporate operations play a major role in Atlanta's economy, as the city claims the nation's third-largest concentration of Fortune 500 companies. It also hosts the global headquarters of corporations like the Coca-Cola Company, The Home Depot, UPS, Delta Air Lines, AT&T Mobility, Chick-fil-A, and Turner Broadcasting. Over 75% of Fortune 1000 companies conduct business operations in the city's metro area, and the region hosts offices of over 1,250 multinational corporations. The city is only a 25-minute drive to Atlanta, which is the 7th-most visited city in the U.S., with over 35 million visitors per year. The most popular attraction among visitors to Atlanta is the Georgia Aquarium, the world's largest indoor aquarium. Atlanta's tourism industry is mostly driven by the city's history museums and outdoor attractions. Atlanta is also home to the World of Coca-Cola, a museum dedicated to the iconic soft drink. Atlanta is home to professional franchises for four major team sports.

Logistics company plans to expand, bring 500 new jobs to **Cobb County**

Vanderlande is a leading manufacturer of airport automation equipment like baggage conveyor belts. The company is headquartered in the Netherlands and has offices in dozens of nations, but has called its Cobb location the central hub of its North American operations for the past 23 years.

Gov. Brian Kemp announced Vanderlande's expansion plans in a press statement Thursday. The increased footprint will grow the company's workforce to 1,250 employees statewide, according to Kemp's office. By February, Vanderlande expects to move into into a newly constructed 152,612-square-foot facility in the three-story Edison Chastain office complex at 3054 Chastain Meadows Parkway Northwest in Marietta. Vanderlande's current Marietta office sits along West Oak Circle within city limits. That warehouse was built in 2005 and is 61,000 square feet.

Vanderlande Industries, a global logistics company, plans to create 500 new jobs and spend \$59 million to expand its North American headquarters in Cobb County.

Vanderlande has already begun hiring for the new positions. One county official said the average salary for the new jobs is more than \$85,000. Margaret Sinclair, a Vanderlande spokeswoman, did not disclose the pay ranges Friday, saying the wages are "competitive within the industry."

"We are really growing strong and believe that our people help us deliver the innovative solutions our customers expect," she wrote in an email Friday.

"I am thrilled a company like Vanderlande is choosing to expand in Cobb County, bringing with them 500 skilled and stable jobs," County Commission Chairwoman Lisa Cupid said Friday. "This is yet another example of how companies of all industries view Cobb as an attractive place for their employees to work."



Marietta named as one of the best places to live in America

"It is an honor to have Marietta placed on both these top tier lists of cities in recognition of our wonderful, vibrant, and diverse community," City Manager Bill Bruton said in a statement.

"Our restaurants, nightlife, museums, and arts scene have flourished over the years to create a place where people want to be. Our outdoor recreation and parks facilities have made our city a sports destination, while our economic development projects and job growth have steadily continued even during the pandemic."

Home to a thriving city square, steeped in history and famous for having a really distinctive KFC, Marietta's not a bad place to live: In fact, it's one of the best. A recently released list included the Atlanta suburb as one of the top-10 cities to live in all of America. It was Georgia's only entry on the list.

The list set out to identify suburbs that had "urban amenities and a big city feel," according to a city release.

"Increased opportunities to work remotely are pushing more Americans to rethink how and where they want to live," a Zillow explanation of the list said. "But even if there's less of a need to live as close to urban job centers, traditional urban amenities — think restaurants, nightlife, museums and sports venues - remain a big draw and demand for city living remains high."


According to the City of Marietta release, the rankings were based on factors that included housing affordability compared to the nearest big cities and to the country at large, housing availability, the mix and diversity of businesses - including restaurants, nightlife and the arts - and consumer reviews and check-ins."

"All of Marietta's amenities combine to place it on this coveted list," the city release said.
