Rent is far below market, the tenant previously extended its lease once already, sales are strong with the tenant approaching the percentage rent break point on multiple occasions, and the lease is absolute



COLTON, CA

Colton is a city in San Bernardino County, California, United States. Nicknamed "Hub City", Colton is located in the Inland Empire region of the state and is a suburb of San Bernardino, approximately 4 miles south of the city's downtown. Colton is the site of Colton Crossing, which was one of the busiest at-grade railroad crossings in the United States. The crossing was installed in 1882 by the California Southern Railroad to cross the Southern Pacific Railroad tracks while building northward from San Diego.

Colton is located in the heart of the nation's largest county which spans more than 20,000 square miles, San Bernardino's border adjoins five California counties and also stretches east touching the state lines of both Nevada and Arizona. Home to 24 cities as well as diverse elevations, multi-faceted terrains, and enviable climates, San Bernardino is known for its wide-open spaces as well as its outdoor adventures, from skiing and snowboarding to hiking and watersports.

The County of San Bernardino welcomes travelers from all corners of the world eager to explore everything from the floor of the Mojave Desert Basin to the alpine villages of Lake Arrowhead and Big Bear. The region also offers outlet shopping, wine tasting, apple picking and an array of eclectic outdoor art installations.

TENANT PROFILE



Carl's Jr. is a quick service restaurant chain that is owned and operated by CKE Restaurant Holdings, Inc. Carl's Jr. delivers innovative menu items and implements a dual brand strategy, pairing some of its 300 locations with a Green Burrito Outlet. Carl's Jr. leases tend to be long term and require no landlord responsibilities from the owner.

Carl's Jr. is the 5th largest fast food chain in size when combined with it's sister chain, Hardee's, and generates approximately \$3.9 billion in system revenues. Located primarily on the West Coast and the Southwest, Carl's Jr. has been able to build its reputation with a contained audience and build brand recognition with consumers in those areas.

Following its founding as a modest BBQ joint in Anaheim, CA, Carl's Jr. began to transform into one of the largest fast food conglomerates in the country. They are most known for their Thickburger line, but have expanded into hand breaded chicken tenders and in 2019 they began selling Beyond Meat patty's, a vegetarian options for plant-based burgers.

Carl's Jr. has a total of 3,800 restaurants that operate in 44 states and 43 foreign countries. Falling under the CKE umbrella, Carl's Jr. is a sister company with fellow burger restaurant Hardee's, effectively splitting the country in half geographically.

May 10, 2022. CKE Restaurant Holdings, the parent company of quick-service brands Carl's Jr. and Hardee's, has announced a systemwide plan to overhaul their restaurants, including extensive remodeling that will involve some \$500 million in investments.


The Franklin, Tenn.-based company said it will spend \$60 million on what it is calling a "brand transformation" that will include new digital menu boards at the drive-thrus and dining rooms, new equipment, streamlined menus and new equipment to make the restaurants more efficient and employees' jobs easier. The remainder of the spending will come from franchisees, whose restaurants make up 94% of the two brands' locations.


