## Urgent care chain opening Miami County site

The urgent care will open on Spring Street, and will join area locations operating in Dayton, Clayton, Huber Heights, Xenia, and Troy.

"We recognized there was a need and opportunity to provide local residents with greater access to quality care with shorter wait times, walk-in service and lower costs than the traditional emergency room," stated Annie Keller, WellNow Urgent Care public relations manager.

The Chicago-based chain now has more than 85 locations in New York, Ohio, Illinois, and Michigan, from opening new locations as well as acquiring chains Hometown Urgent Care and MASH.

WellNow Urgent Care treats non-life-threatening injuries and illnesses such as sprains, burns, lacerations, colds and allergies while also providing on-site X-rays, lab testing and physicals, and **all locations** also do COVID-19 testing, according to Keller.

The chain started in **2011** as Five Star Urgent Care and rebranded as WellNow Urgent Care in **2018**. Its a **wholly-owned subsidiary** of Aspen Dental Management.



# WellNow considers expansion possibilities beyond urgent care

With two new sites open this month in Hamburg and Springville and four more in Canandaigua, Webster, Glens Falls and Troy by year's end, WellNow Urgent Care has no plans to slow down.

The Buffalo company is looking to **expand services** beyond urgent care and occupational health, though founder Dr. John Radford said he's not quite sure what. **"There are opportunities out there,"** he said. "We're just trying to really figure out what the best fit would be, what we're able **to do well** and what's within our wheelhouse."

The 10-year-old company announced in early November that the workforce will increase by 25% with the addition of 300 people (including 75 in Western New York) in nearly 50 locations in New York and Illinois as it prepares to open 20 sites in each of the next two years.

Radford is watching competitors nationwide, including different care models offered by nontraditional providers such as Walmart, with walk-in clinics, and CVS, which has grown its MinuteClinic network to 1,100 locations in 33 states.

Radford is looking at **population health add-ons** that make sense, especially for younger people who may not have established relationships with **a primary-care provider**.

"These folks that grew up on urgent care, these folks are going to be **50-60 years** old and need colonoscopies and other services. What can we do from the population health side?" he said. "We're starting to see a **different model** come out from that perspective, none that have taken any **strong foothold**, but the industry is trying to figure out what's next, and where it may evolve beyond sore throats, ankle sprains and acute non-emergency things."









# South Bend ranked as one of the best places to live in the U.S.

Three Indiana communities were ranked in the top 150 places to live in the United States.

U.S. News and World Report released its **annual list** which includes Indianapolis, Fort Wayne, and South Bend. South Bend comes in at **number 70**. The ranking is based on affordability, being a desirable place to live, having a strong job market, and a **high quality** of life.

U.S. News and World Report says the city's efforts to revitalize the St. Joseph River area is helping attract young professionals. One of the factors that led them to rank South Bend 70th on their list, a major milestone for a city that struggled not so long ago.

After analyzing **150** of the highest population areas in the country, U.S. News found South Bend is rebounding from tough economic challenges and steady population decreases since the **1980s**.

"Unlike most parks that are just like here's a swing, here's a slide, this park has a lot more."

"Folks are making decisions to move to **communities**, they're looking at lists just like this."

says South Bend Regional Chamber of Commerce President Jeff Rea. "We were pretty thrilled to see this it's sort of the exact opposite of what we saw a little bit more than a decade ago when **Newsweek ranked** us one of the **10 most dying cities** in the world."

There's hope this positive news brings **opportunities** to the city.

"Now that we're in a **higher rank**, I think you're going to continue to see **increased development** which is something we're already seeing, apartment complexes going up,"
says Howard Hanna SB Real Estate Broker Abram Christianson. "We're starting to see a
wider array of **restaurants popping** up here and there. A lot more incubator spaces which
is really exciting."



# Four Winds Casino South Bend moving closer to completing expansion

Developing now at Four Winds Casino in South Bend is the next big investment to bring more gaming, entertainment, and gathering spaces to Northwest Indiana.

Construction is moving right along with an expansion of the casino floor, event centers, and their **23-story high-rise** hotel. They're going all in at Four Winds Casino in South Bend. The expansion will make up roughly a **third of the entire property** footprint when it's all wrapped up.

The new 317-room high rise will host a variety of new amenities that also cater to guests who aren't trying to ante up.

Four Winds Casino is doubling down by adding 850 new slot machines, 11 new table games, and 45,000 sq/ft of additional space to their casino floor.

While the new development is sure to **attract high rollers**, it will also offer a new appeal to more casual visitors.

"A lot of people don't want to come in and game. They want to come in and enjoy a nice meal, we have one of the **top steakhouses** in the area. We'll be able to provide a pool area for the restaurant to sit and eat. We'll have concerts. Even if it's just entertainment in Kankakee with the two-person band in there. Not everyone wants to game and we think we can capture a **lot more people** who just want to come out for a night of entertainment and want to get away for a while," said Four Winds South Bend GM Scott Rice.

This hallway will connect the new wing to the rest of the gaming floor while also serving as **entrances** to their future spa and shopping area.


It will also lead folks to what will be their **24,000 sq/ft** Ribbon Town Conference and Event Center.

"600 sit down dinner in our ballroom, which can also be divided into three to serve more parties and multiple bookings, as well as eleven additional small meeting rooms for smaller breakout sessions," said Hotel Operations Senior VP Mary Smith.
