

## Dollar General Takes 'First Major Step' Toward Expanding Healthcare Products in Stores

Dollar General may have taken the its first step toward adding pharmacy services to its stores, a move that could require the chain to reshuffle some real estate.

The Goodlettsville, Tennessee-based retailer said it will increase healthcare offerings in its 17,426 stores in 46 states. The move includes cough and cold, dental, nutritional, medical, health aids and feminine hygiene products. Dollar General said it has hired as **chief medical officer** Dr. Albert Wu, who worked for five years at consulting firm McKinsey & Co. and led a team that created a total cost-of-care model for 250,000 rural healthcare patients.

Dollar General is just the latest national chain to expand into healthcare, a move that has the potential to boost foot traffic at its stores.

Most of Dollar General's stores are in rural areas, and the retailer often notes that **75%** of the U.S. population lives within **about 5 miles** of a Dollar General store.

While Dollar General is **increasing its healthcare** products, drugstore chains Walgreens and CVS are moving into healthcare services. Walgreens is opening **primary-care clinics** with Chicago-based VillageMD in a quest to become a neighborhood health destination. For its part, CVS has been adding HealthHubs and MinuteClinics in stores.

Todd Vasos, Dollar General's CEO, said in the company's statement that "our customers have told us that they would like to see **increased access** to affordable healthcare products and services in their communities" and that the retailer's goal is to "build and enhance affordable **healthcare offerings** for our customers, especially in the rural communities we serve."







Greensburg is a home rule-class city in and the county seat of Green County, Kentucky.

Greensburg is located east of the center of Green County on the north side of the Green River, a west-flowing tributary of the Ohio River.

The Little Barren and Green River are two of the top 25 recommended streams in Kentucky for smallmouth bass fishing.

The Downtown Greensburg Historic District is on the National Register of Historic Places and includes the oldest courthouse west of the Allegheny Mountains.

U.S. Route 68 passes through the city as Main Street; it leads northeast 11 miles to Cambellsville and southwest 25 miles to Edmonton. Kentucky Route 61 joins US 68 on Main Street through Greensburg; KY 61 leads northwest 40 miles to Elizabethtown and southeast 19 miles to Columbia. Old Court House is one the oldest public buildings still standing in Kentucky, the courthouse was built in 1802, it is the oldest courthouse west of the Allegheny Mountains. The Green River Paddle Trail begins at the spillway below the Green River Lake Dam in Taylor County and extends to the Hart County line. The trail included parts of the Little Barren River and Russell Creek and offers canoeing, bird and wildlife watching, fishing, hunting, and other recreational activities. The Little Barren and Green River are two of the top 25 recommended streams in Kentucky for smallmouth bass fishing. The Green River. the fourth most biologically diverse river in the US and the longest and most diverse of Kentucky's rivers, is home to 151 fish species and 71 mussel species, some of which are found nowhere else. Green River Lake is made up of 8,200 acres surrounded by 1,331 acres of land. There are activities for everyone including: miniature golf, swimming, hiking, fishing, horseback riding, and boating.

## Unemployment rate is the lowest in state history

According to the Kentucky Center for Statistics, an agency within the Education and Workforce Development Cabinet, Kentucky's seasonally adjusted preliminary April 2022 unemployment rate was 3.9%, the lowest rate ever recorded since the U.S. Bureau of Labor and Statistics began reporting state rates in 1976.

Kentucky Chamber of Commerce officials say only 58% of the adult population is working. "Where it is very difficult for employers to hire enough workers to meet the demand of consumers," said Charles Aull, Kentucky Chamber of Commerce.

The governor also says Kentucky is bringing in more tax revenue, saying that general fund receipts collected more than \$1.84 billion, in reporting just last week.

2021 featured a record \$11.2 billion in private-sector new location and expansion projects and the creation of 18,000-plus full-time jobs.

"Kentucky's economy is absolutely on fire, and today's report shows that continued success is benefiting Kentuckians across the commonwealth," Gov. Beshear said. "We've secured our spot as a leader by establishing Kentucky as the capital for electric vehicle battery production and agritech. But even more important, we're building a Kentucky where our people can create a better life through great jobs, world-class education opportunities, quality health care and strong infrastructure. We're not just talking about building a better Kentucky - we're doing it."

The Kentucky Republican Party says Gov. Beshear is putting a spin on unemployment numbers. Spokesman Sean Southard says the labor force has 20,000 fewer people today than when Beshear was first elected and the state is dealing with numerous issues they say are from the "Biden-Beshear" economy, such as high gas prices and baby formula shortages.

## Greensburg community excited to welcome new manufacturer

In the small town of Greensburg, times have been tough. Over the past few decades, the town and surrounding community have lost multiple businesses and hundreds of jobs.

Thousands of jobs were lost when the Fruit of the Loom factory in neighboring Taylor County closed. Local workers were also impacted when a host of other facilities closed: Anaconda Wire and Cable, Clark Casual Furniture, Greensburg Manufacturing and others.

The expansion will include 25 jobs with a \$1.42 million investment.

But, finally, community leaders like Judge Executive John Frank have good news.

"To say this is a big deal would be an understatement," said Frank.

Mayor John Shuffett says while 25 jobs might not sound like a huge amount, they'll be the first manufacturing jobs created in Green County in at least two decades.

"It's a big deal for our community," the mayor said. "It's a blue-collar community, and you know, we're flush with skilled labor. They just all have to leave the county and go to work, and so, I think the dream would be to bring our workforce home."

Mike Griffiths, with the county's economic development wing, the Green Economic Team, sees the investment as just a start.

"We're in hope that that breeds other ones to come here and want to open businesses," he


Nearby, other signs of life are already showing. New retailers, like Ace Hardware, are under construction. A brand new hospital is coming too.
