# Dollar General Plans to Open 1,050 Locations in 2023

Dollar General is continuing its rapid expansion into fiscal 2023 with plans for 1,050 new stores, following a successful Q3 2022 when sales rose 11.1% to \$9.5 billion. The quarter, which ended Oct. 28, also saw a 6.8% increase in same-store sales driven by larger basket sizes and a small increase in traffic.

"We are thankful to our team for their continued dedication to serving others, particularly in a **challenging economic** and operating environment," said Jeff Owen, CEO of Dollar General in a statement. "We are pleased with our strong sales growth in the quarter, as well as a **modest increase** in customer traffic and continued **share gains** in both consumable and non-consumable product sales, all of which we believe are a testament to the **strength of the value** and convenience proposition we offer our customers."

Dollar General also is growing through the addition of three 1-million-squarefoot distribution centers in an approximately \$480 million combined investment announced in July. The facilities will support the DG Private Fleet and help the retailer achieve its goal of creating 10,000 net new jobs in 2022.

The off-price retailer executed on **800 retail projects** in **Q3 2022** and plans to execute on an additional 3,170 in the coming year. These efforts include **2,000 remodels**, and **120 store relocations** and up to 35 stores in Mexico.

The company also expanded its interest in medtail with the appointment of four members to its healthcare advisory panel. The retailer is developing investment strategies in the health and wellness category but has yet to make an official move.



# Dollar General's new Popshelf stores chase inflation-weary shoppers in the suburbs

Dollar General's next big strategy for growth is tucked in a strip mall in suburban Nashville, and it is coming to other cities soon. It's a new store called Popshelf. Over the past two years, the Tennessee-based discounter has tested the store concept, which caters to suburban shoppers with higher incomes, but sells most items for \$5 or less.

A wide range of merchandise fills the shelves, including holiday-themed platters, party and crafting supplies, novelty foods such as **gourmet chocolates** and Portobello mushroom jerky, and **gifts** like dangly earrings, lip gloss and toys. It's designed to be a **treasure hunt** that keeps shoppers coming back.

Now, with inflation still high, Dollar General is ramping up its plans for Popshelf. It aims to double the banner's locations to approximately 300 stores next year. Over the next three years, it plans to grow to about 1,000 locations across the country. Eventually, it sees an opportunity to reach about 3,000 total locations. It is also testing mini Popshelf shops inside of some of its Dollar General stores. So far, it has about 40 of those shops.

But Popshelf will have to **prove** it can hold up in a tougher economy. Walmart, Best Buy, Costco and others have warned of weaker sales of discretionary items as consumers spend more on necessities. Target recently cut its holiday quarter forecast, and Kohl's pulled its outlook, citing **middle-income consumers** who feel stretched.

On Dollar General's recent earnings call, CEO Jeff Owen said even customers who make \$100,000 a year have been shopping at its stores.

Chief Merchandising Officer Emily Taylor said Popshelf can draw spending-conscious shoppers by offering items that don't cause guilt.









Dayton is a city and county seat in Rhea County, Tennessee, United States. As of the 2020 census, the city population was 7,065.

The Dayton Urban Cluster, which includes developed areas adjacent to the city and extends south to Graysville.

Dayton is located roughly 35 miles northeast of downtown Chattanooga.

Dayton is a small manufacturing center whose products include furniture, clothing, automobile parts, and recreational vehicle components. La-Z-Boy is the largest manufacturing employer, followed by Suburban Manufacturing, Robinson

Manufacturing, and International Automotive Components Group. Finland-based Nokian Tyres plans to employ around 400 at its new Dayton tire manufacturing factory which began initial operations in 2019. The Tennessee Valley Authority's Watts Bar and Sequoyah nuclear power plants are both within 20 miles of the city. Since the late 1990s the area has experienced increased residential development particularly along Chickamauga Lake, an impoundment of the Tennessee River. More recently, Dayton has hosted several major bass fishing tournaments at Chickamauga Lake including the 2014 Bassmaster BASSfest, American Bass Anglers Weekend Series, Heartland Anglers Classic, the 2013 Walmart FLW Tour and various senior, collegiate and high school events

# Study: Tennessee could add 1 million new residents by 2040

Researchers at the University of Tennessee released a study Wednesday estimating that Tennessee's population could grow by one million over the next two decades.

The report released by The Boyd Center for Business and Economic Research offers new population projections through 2070 for all 95 counties with breakdowns by age and race. With the state's population listed as 6.9 million following the 2020 Census, researchers project population growth could push Tennessee's population to nearly 8 million by 2040.

The Knoxville Metropolitan Statistical Area, which is comprised of Knox, Blount, Anderson, Loudon and Union counties, is projected to grow by 13.3% over the same time frame. Current projections would add over 116,000 new residents, pushing the Knoxville MSA population to nearly one million.

The main driver of state population growth will likely occur in the 13-county Nashville Metropolitan Statistical Area. Researchers estimate this area will grow by 563,000 people in the next 20 years, accounting for 57 percent of the state's projected total increase.

Knox County is estimated to add over 80,000 residents by 2040, an increase of 17.2%. The state's 78 rural counties are expected to add more than 225,000 new residents, an increase of 8.9 percent. Urban counties are projected to add about 765,000 residents, an increase of 17.5 percent.

Projections estimate Tennessee's median age will climb from 38.8 years to 40.7 years by 2040, driven by an increase in the senior population.



# Biden-Harris Administration Awards Tennessee Companies \$500M to Supercharge Battery Manufacturing

The Biden-Harris Administration, through the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE), today announced the first set of projects funded by the President's Bipartisan Infrastructure Law to expand domestic manufacturing of batteries for electric vehicles (EVs) and the electrical grid and for materials and components currently imported from other countries.

The 20 companies will receive a **combined \$2.8 billion** to build and expand commercial-scale facilities in **12 states** to extract and process lithium, graphite and other battery materials, manufacture components, and demonstrate new approaches, including manufacturing components **from recycled materials**. Three new battery component processing and manufacturing facilities are coming to **Chattanooga**, **Clarksville and McMinn County** and will receive more than **\$500 million** to help Tennessee expand its role as a **manufacturing powerhouse**.


Novonix will build a new plant producing 30,000 metric tons per year of graphite for the EV industry to reduce U.S. reliance on importing this key battery component material. The project includes significant involvement with and support for NAM's local community in Chattanooga. It will directly create 1,400 clean-energy, good-paying jobs while demonstrating our commitment to community engagement, innovative workforce development programming, and active recruitment among traditionally marginalized communities.

The federal investment will be matched by recipients to leverage a total of more than \$9 billion to boost American production of clean energy technology, create good-paying jobs, and support President Biden's national goals for electric vehicles to make up half of all new vehicle sales by 2030 and to transition to a net-zero emissions economy by 2050.
