BYRAM, NEW JERSEY

Byram Township is a township in Sussex County, in the U.S. state of New Jersey. As of the 2022, the township's population was 8,115. The municipality is known as the "Township of Lakes", as there are roughly two dozen lakes and ponds within its borders.

Byram is home to local companies such as Byram Day Care Center, Ally's Art and Frame Co., and Big Apple Electricians.

Byram Township is known as the "Gateway to New Jersey Trails". The township has several municipal parks: C.O. Johnson Park, Riverside Park, Tomahawk Park, Allamuchy Mountain State Park, Neil Gylling Memorial Park, Brookwood Park. Cranberry Lake is a man-made lake, is bordered on the east by U.S. Route 206 and the Sussex Branch Trail. The local community is bordered on the north and south by Allamuchy Mountain State Park. The Cranberry Lake footbridge, one of the oldest pedestrian footbridges in NJ transverses the lake from east to west and connects the west shore of the community with the Sussex Branch Trail.

The Byram Township School District serves public school students in kindergarten through eighth grade. Schools in the district are Byram Lakes Elementary School and Byram Intermediate School. For public school students in ninth through twelfth grades, the township shares Lenape Valley Regional High School, which also serves Netcong in Morris County and the Sussex County community of Stanhope. Private schools in the area include Reverend Brown in Sparta for grades K–8. Hilltop Country Day School.

The nearest major airport is Trenton-Mercer Airport. This airport has domestic flights from Trenton, New Jersey and is 21 miles from the center of Byram, NJ.

Sussex County is the northernmost county in the U.S. state of New Jersey. Its county seat is Newton. It is part of the New York metropolitan area and is part of New Jersey's Skylands Region. Sussex County, New Jersey's estimated 2023 population is 142,709.
